Selected Cyprus White Wines

Xinisteri (Local Variety)

Xynisteri is the most wide-spread white grape variety in the Cypriot vineyard. The vinification of grapes from selected regions at low temperatures produces fresh, light-colored, aromatic wines with medium alcohol levels, which are not usually amenable to ageing and must be drunk when young.

Other White Varieties

Spourtiko (local variety) **€22.90**

Vouni Panayia Winery-Panayia, Paphos (2)

The name Spourtiko means "bursting", a reference to its berries whose fragile skin splits easily. A lovely medium bodied white with a satisfactory long finish.

Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc **€19.90**

Zambartas winery- Ayios Amvrosios, Lemesos (4) . With a luscious taste of tropical fruit, hints of spice and smoky oak that linger in the mouth, this is a refined, intense & complex wine.

Sauvignon Blanc **€18.90**

Tsiakkas Winery- Pelendri Pitsilia, Troodos mountains (6). A zesty citrus nose, fresh acidity, tastes of tropical fruits and a long finish.

Chardonnay **€18.90**

Tsiakkas Winery- Pelendri Pitsilia, Troodos mountains (6). With lovely apricot & peach perfumed aromas this wine has a fresh acidity & excellent ripe fruit, which appears sweet. Long delicious finish.

Viognier **€22.90**

Argyrides Winery- Vasa Kilaniou (4)

Like Chardonnay, Viognier has the potential to produce full-bodied wines with a lush, soft character.

Rose Wines

Pambela **€15.90**

Vouni Panayia Winery-Panayia, Paphos (2)

Refreshing, well-balanced with red fruit flavours on the palate and a lively finish.

Cornetto Medium & Dry **€14.50**

Kolios Winery- Statos-Ayios Fotios, Pafos (2)

Rose wines with refined aromas and thirst quenching fruitiness and freshness.

Tsangarides Rose Shiraz **€14.50**

Tsangarides Winery- Lemona, Pafos (2)

With a particularly appealing rose color, this wine has a supple, full and warm taste.

Selected Cyprus Red Wines

Yiaskouris, Pachna

Grape Varietal of Carigan Noir & Shiraz, this is a quality wine with a deep purple colour, low acidity and a rich complex aroma.

Ayios Efrem

A special blend of Mataro Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz grapes give this wine its rich colour and flavours of light spices, berries, coffee and pepper.

Ayios Fotios

An excellently balanced dry red wine with a smooth velvety taste.

A balanced & full wine, deep in colour, that is vivid in aroma & fruity in taste.

Vouni Panayia Winery-Panayia, Paphos (2)
A lovely crimson red this wine is intriguingly aromatic with fruity aromas of cherry, raspberry, blackberry. It has a soft, round palate which leads to a persistent finish of plum.

Kyperounda Winery- Kyperouna Pitsilia, Troodos mountains (6)
The harmonious union of the French varieties Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache and Mourvedre brings us a wine of deep red colour where the aroma of red fruits and spices blended with oak notes lend it a unique mildly bitter flavour.

Maratheftiko (Local Variety)

Maratheftiko is an ancient grape variety indigenous to Cyprus. Grown mainly in the Pitsilia region of the Troodos Mountains. Maratheftiko produces a range of medium to full-bodied wines with deep purple to ruby colour, a violet bouquet, delicate cherry flavours, firm tannins and fresh acidity with ageing possibilities.

Shiraz

Or Syrah...One of the world's most diverse and successful grape varieties, Syrah wines can display myriad dark-fruit flavors. Varietal Syrah can be quite floral in its youth, developing more peppery notes as it ages.

Food matches include pork spare ribs with barbecue sauce and strong hard cheeses especially cheddar.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Is one of the world's most widely recognized red wine grape varieties which always seem to demonstrate a handful of common character traits: deep color, good tannin structure, moderate acidity and aromas of blackcurrant, tomato leaf, dark spices and cedarwood. It pairs well with: Fillet Steak & Red Meat.

Mourvèdre (Mataró)

Mourvèdre tends to produce tannic wines that can be high in alcohol. according to wine expert Jancis Robinson Mourvèdre wines often have wild game and/or earthy notes to them, with soft red fruit flavors. Young Mourvèdre can come across as faulted due to the reductive, sulfur notes and "farmyard-y" flavors that some wines can exhibit before those flavors mellow with age.

Tsangarides “organic” €26.90

Tsangarides Winery- Lemona, Pafos (2)

A complex bouquet of spice with raspberry, plum & caramel. Warm, subtle and well balanced. Very smooth not too tannic, with a rich and fruity aftertaste.

Argyrides “mourvedre” €26.90

Argyrides Winery- Vasa Kilaniou (4)

Great aroma and taste, strong body, smooth tannins and balance in the mouth.

French White Wines

Chardonnay 2015, Remy Ferbras €16.90

A yellow green colour with a refreshing acidity and freshness on the mouth. Pleasing aromas of white flowers and fruits on the nose.

Chablis 2014, William Fevre €39.90

An elegant bouquet, developing citrus, white fruit & floral notes. Fresh and supple, combining a lovely fruitiness & minerality.

French Red Wine

Beaujolais Village 2012, Villa Ponciago €28.90

A vivid garnet colour with an intensely fruity bouquet. The palate shows delicately tender and sweet.

Cote du Rhone A.O.C, Grande Serres, 2013 €22.90

Deep red with aromas of cassis, blueberry, thyme & black pepper. It gives an inviting fruity taste with an agreeable sweetness towards the finish.

Bordeaux 2013, Chateau Pradignac €21.90

With a sweet purple colour. This is a well-concentrated wine, intense and elegant. Its aromas are full of charm, rich, with mature fruit notes.

New World White Wines

Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Montes (Chile) €24.90

Pale yellow in colour this is a fresh, crisp, happy wine with attractive notes of tropical fruit and grassiness.

Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Bishops Leap, Marlborough (New Zealand) €32.90

A crisp wine with intense aromas & flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant, gooseberry, herbs & honeysuckle.

Chenin Blanc 2015, Delheim (South Africa) €24.90

Lively lemon & stone fruit flavours with a creaminess & touch of honey. A crisp & zesty wine with crunchy green apple on the finish.

New World Red Wines

Merlot 2014, Montes Reserva (Chile) €24.90

A young Merlot with six months American oak ageing. Elegant and refined with marked fruitiness and spicy black pepper.

Syrah 2013, Montes Alpha (Chile) €39.90

This wine is of an intense ruby red color, it has a great aroma of floral, tobacco & leather notes. Strong & full-bodied on the palate, with soft and mature tannins.

Italian Red Wines

Merlot – Cabernet (IGT Luna di Luna) €27.90

Grapes: 60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon
Velvety with soft tannins and aromas of red fruits and spices.

Valpolicella Classico DOC (Campagnola) €26.90

Grapes: Corvina Veronese 40%, Corvinone 40%, Rondinella 20%. Deep ruby red. Vinous, delicate, fruity bouquet. Dry, harmonious, soft with a bitter aftertaste.

Chianti Classico DOCG (Rocca delle Macie) €34.90

Grape varieties: Sangiovese 95%, Merlot 5%
A lively ruby red colour, savoury & full-bodied it is intense & persistent with hints of wild berries that combine well with the aromas released by the wood of the barrels.

Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOCG (Campagnola) €69.50

Grapes: Corvina Veronese and Corvinone Veronese 65%, Rondinella 35%. Intense ruby red colour with a violet edge. Warm, spicy, powerful bouquet with intense aromas of cherry, bitter almond and vanilla. Full, rich, velvety flavor.

Italian White Wines

Chardonnay–Pinot Grigio (IGT Luna di Luna) €25.90

Grapes: 70% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Grigio
Bright straw yellow colour. Tropical fruit aromas and a crisp persistent finish.

Lugana DOC (Campagnola)

Grapes: Trebbiano di Lugana (Turbiana) 100%,
Light straw colour. A delicate floral bouquet with fruity notes. Dry taste, fresh, velvety, with right acidity, and almond aftertaste.

Pinot Grigio DOC (Terre di Valfredda Ca Montini)

Grapes: 100% Pinot Grigio
Straw yellow colour, crisp and vibrant with notes of apple and citrus on the nose with a nicely balanced fruit and acidity.

Gavi DOCG. (Pio Cesare)

€49.95

Grapes: 100% Cortese

Ripe fruit with freshness and a clean spicy fragrance, good complex flavour, smooth, silky, rich and slightly aromatic, meant to be consumed young but it can age in the bottle up to 3 years.

Light pink color. Fresh, fruity, cherry bouquet, dry, harmonious, lively, lightly bitter aftertaste.

La Marca Prosecco is produced from 100% Glera grape. This sparkling wine is pale, golden straw in color with light & crisp finish.


Prosecco Rose Fantinel

A classic pink Prosecco with fine and persistent mousse, hints of red fruits and floralness with an elegant and long finish.
