SELECTED CYPRIOT WHITE WINES

FROM INDIGENOUS VARIETIES

XINISTERI

Xinisteri (Xynisteri) is the prevailing white grape variety of the Cypriot vineyard. It produces excellent light coloured white wines with low alcohol levels and acidity especially when it is cultivated in such regions as Laona of Akamas, Ambelitis, Vouni Panayia, Pitsillia and certain areas of the wine regions due to the micro-climate conditions.

Its grapes do not have an intense aroma, it is therefore imperative during the winemaking process to look for a secondary source of aromas for example by making wine from clear must or letting it ferment at low temperatures. This is the only other variety apart from Mavro that is used for making Commandaria wine.

SPOURTIKO

Spourtiko is a very rare, indigenous, white grape variety grown in Cyprus. It represents only 0.2% of cultivated vineyards on the island and is mostly grown amongst other grape varieties.

Nowadays, Spourtiko is mostly planted with Maratheftiko grapevines in order to help it overcome its pollination problem. The majority of Spourtiko vineyards are located in the paphos regions in villages such as Kili (500m) and Panayia (1100m). Spourtiko grapes are delicate and burst easily when they are overripe, that is why the variety was named Spourtiko. In Cypriot dialect Spourtiko means "bursting". Wines made from Spourtiko have a yellow-green colour are low in alcohol and have a herbaceous and citrus character. This type of wine is mostly consumed as an aperitif or with very light dishes.

PROMARA

Promara is a long forgotten white grape variety indigenous to Cyprus. It is the first Cypriot variety to ripen every year hence its name. Currently, the Promara vineyards represent less than 1% of the total vineyard are in Cyprus. Promara has a complex aromatic profile of stone and citrus fruit. Medium body with refreshing acidity and long aftertaste.

MOROKANELLA

Produces light to medium body, fragrant wines with floral aromas mainly white flowers. In the glass we have pale yellow colour wines, with floral notes of orange blossom and carnation, citrus character, light body wines with short finish. It pairs nicely with light fish dishes and salads, but it can be enjoyed as an aperitif.

MARATHEFTIKO

Maratheftiko is an indigenous grape variety that has only recently been cultivated to produce premium wines. Traditionally, this variety was grown within vineyards of mostly Mavro grapes to improve the tint and body of the Mavro. In the days when grapes were sold by weight. Maratheftiko was out of favour because it produces small light fruit. Yet many winemakers now consider it the top red variety of Cyprus and are seeking to harness its potential.

A Maratheftiko wine usually has a shimmering dark red colouring with a hint of blue. Often likened to merlot, the wine exhibits delicate flowery aromas and rich flavourings of cherry and dark chocolate. It is a challenge to produce it. The vine is prone to intense flowering and uneven ripening yielding bunches of differently sized berries. Unlike most grape varieties, Maratheftiko cannot self-pollinate. Consequently, most growers plant Maratheftiko with Spourtiko, a white variety that flowers at the same time and helps with the pollination of the Maratheftiko. Vamvakada is a synonym for the variety situated in Pitsilia region.

YIANNOUDI

Yiannoudi is a rare indigenous grape variety in Cyprus. Its grapes are round, have thick skin and produce wines rich in colour, tannins and acidity. A typical Yiannoudi has flavours of blackberry, dark cherry and blueberry notes. Yiannoudi means "little John"

SELECTED CYPRIOT ROSE WINES

FROM INDIGENOUS VARIETIES

Rose wines are made from a wide variety of grapes, such as Mavro, Shiraz, Cabernet Franc. Here in Cyprus, we produce rose using the skin contact method. Black skin grapes are crushed, and skins are allowed to remain in contact with the juice for a short period. The less time the skin remains in the grape juice, the lighter colour the wine will be.

SELECTED CYPRIOT DESSERT WINES FROM INDIGENOUS VARIETIES

COMMANDARIA

Commandaria is a dessert wine with flavour as rich as its history. It is originally believed to have been given its name by crusading knights in the 13th century, but to have first been made up of 5,000 years ago according to ancient Greek poet Hesiod, stated in his didactic poem Works and Days written at the end of the 8th century BC.

It is produced in the fertile high-altitude slopes in the south-west of the island that became known as "La Grande Commanderie" during the Crusades. Around this time, the Knights of the Order of Saint John renamed the local wine after their new protectorate. Throughout the following centuries, stories of the wine abound. According to the legend, King Richard the Lionheart of England was so taken with commandaria that as his wedding he pronounced it "the wine of the kings and the king of wines".

Commandaria is recognized as the oldest named wine in the world.

In 1993, the European Union registered "Commandaria" as a protected name and geographical origin. Commandaria AOC the designated region of Cyprus, home to the rich, amber-coloured Commandaria dessert wine which can be produced only in the strictly defined region comprising 14 wine-producing villages in their Troodos foothills about 20 miles (30km) north of the city of Limassol, following certain ageing requirements and using only 2 indigenous grape varieties, Xinisteri and Mavro.

Their sweetness is entirely natural-the result of the high sugar levels wine grapes can achieve in Cyprus warm climate, later concentrated by the drying process the grapes undergo before vinification. Fortified and Unfortified examples of Commandaria are now available in the market.

Tasting Notes: Light straw yellow colour and a bouquet of citrus-still grapefruit and lemon. Green apples and white flowers follow suit, and a little iodine sneaks in as a representative of the iron oxide. The taste is fresh and tight.

Tasting Notes: Deep Morello cherry colour with garnet tints. Fine and very aromatic wine with a very good persistence. Nice aromas of orange, blackcurrant with a hint of violet. Liquorice and tabacco notes at the end. Elegant and powerful wine, sweetness and finesse at the end.

Domaine Coste Caumartin Pammard 1er Cru les Fremiers 2017-2018

Tasting Notes: The characteristic of this is wine is the palate, quite firm and solid, bringing out very fine tannins wrapped with pretty fruits. Aromas of blackberry and gooseberry blossoming into a beautiful amplitude that makes the finale particularly persistent.

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby-red in colour, with violet tones. The nose is elegant and complex with aromas of very well-blended ripe red and black fruit. Aromas of crème de cassis, tabacco, and black pepper stand out against a backdrop of toast and pastry notes. The palate is smooth but well structured. Its round and near-sweet tannins balance very well with the acidity.
